When you receive this, you and I will have celebrated Christmas. I hope this Christmas was meaningful to you, and you could celebrate the birth of Christ Jesus in peace with joy.

Last evening, I watched a short video about a Lutheran Theologian, named Paul Tillich, and his book "Courage to Be." He was born August 20, 1886, in a small village in Germany. He went on to become a "giant" in the world of theology in the 20th century. The following statement by this influential thinker is from his book "The Courage to Be": "The courage to be is rooted in the God who appears when God has disappeared in the anxiety of doubt."

The book appeared in 1952 and is as relevant as ever. Paul Tillich was born and educated in Germany. When he resisted the Nazi movement, his life was upset. It was in 1933, after Hitler had assumed power, and Tillich had spoken out against Nazi thinking. Soon after, he was released from his teaching position at a University in Germany. Soon after this, Reinhold Neibuhr of the Union Theological Seminary in New York encouraged Tillich to come and take a position on its faculty. He did so that year. He stayed in the United States for the rest of his life, teaching and writing.

I believe that today, courage is what we need more than almost anything. Courage and faith. Faith is God's gift. Courage is a blessing from God's hand. I also think it can be cultivated. Prayer and worship enhance our courage. Christmas's message is Immanuel, *God with us*, has come. God has come to save and to confirm that we are accepted. Though we are unacceptable, we are accepted! "While we were still sinners, Christ died for the ungodly," (Romans chapter 5, verse 6). God's love and acceptance of each of us is revealed in Jesus' life and teachings and the New Testament. This acceptance brings us joy.

This acceptance gives us courage to be. Mary showed great courage when she received, and accepted, the promise that she would be the mother of the Jesus, the eternal Son of God. She was a young woman, probably still a teenager. The apostles showed good courage in accepting the invitation to follow Jesus. And even if they didn't always "hit the mark" in their understanding, or their actions in response, he embraced them with a commanding love.

As we enter this New Year, we will also look back on the past year. What are you grateful for? How has God given you "courage to be" for the past year? I am sure that all of us fail to *consistently* live with faith and courage. Yet, God accepts and loves us still.

Here are a couple more quotes from Tillich's timeless book.

"He who participates in God participates in eternity."

"The typical American, after he has lost the foundations of his existence, works for new foundations."

As we enter the New Year, may God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit, bless you (and all of us) with, faith, hope, and love; and the courage to be.

A devotion and opening prayer was given by Pastor Dan.

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> The minutes from the November council meeting were reviewed by each council member. No corrections or additions. Minutes accepted as read.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Financial reports were emailed to each member. No discussion was held.

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> A written report was given to each council member. Pastor spoke on a few highlights including holding a council retreat at Luther Crest in February, colleges of the ELCA and Element.

Committee Reports:

- Council approved the Personnel Committees recommended salary increases.

- Annual Meeting date has been set for Sunday, February 20th at 11:00am. Discussion was held about holding a meal after the meeting.
- A Boy Scouts Bankruptcy letter was received through the synod office. Eugene talked with Bob Dalager and it doesn't seem to apply to us.
